A Message From Pastor John



Just a few lines, my friend...

I looked at a topological map of Jerusalem as I prepared for the Palm Sunday message. Everything was so close. In about half of the distance around Lake Hollingsworth, Jesus travelled down from the village of Bethany, up the east side of the Mount of Olives to the village of Bethphage, further up to the crest and then down the west side of the Mount of Olives, across the Kidron Valley, and to the gates of Jerusalem. That was the Triumphal Entry route. A mile and a half. That short trip set into motion the most significant and impactful week in

human history, a week we rightfully call Holy Week.

Holy Week begins on Sunday. See the activities at church below. I encourage you to read the stories of Holy Week in your Bible. Be present in worship all week. Pray Thursday night and through the day on Good Friday at the Prayer Vigil. Prepare yourself and, if possible, your family and friends inwardly for the greatest story ever told. This is the story of the final events of the earthly work of Jesus. Join us all week. Bring your family and friends. Have a deep and meaningful Holy Week.





Be still, you say,


So we wait for the moment. Ignorant of the pain and violence, Unknowing of the fear and suffering, The price for the prize.
