### **Rooted in Faith, Growing for our Future**

As of Oct. 15, we have 130 commitments (representing 202 people) to our Rooted in Faith annual giving emphasis. This number equates to 19% of our active members. Thus far, we have received \$1,176,182 in commitments toward our approximately \$3 million budget.

Our Growing for our Future capital campaign has received 111 commitments (representing 182 people) which equates to 17.1% of our congregation.

The total dollar amount committed for the Growing for our Future campaign is \$1,612,102.

Our goals go beyond meeting the 2026 budget and reaching the \$2 million goal for the growth of our Next Gen spaces. We're praying for something deeper - for every member to participate. Each commitment, no matter the size, is a reflection of your spiritual journey and your shared commitment to what God is doing through First Presbyterian Church.
