Tom Ingui Presents Bach Concert

Next Sunday, Sept. 27, Tom Ingui, FPC organist, will present the second in his nine concert series, The Complete Organ Works of J.S. Bach.

The free concert will be at 3 pm in the sanctuary. The concert is free, and all are invited.

In this performance, Tom will present the Trio Sonatas. He says this is a collection of six "charming" three-movement works. Bach's trio sonatas are amongst the most profound and beloved works for the organ.

Despite their transparent and light character, these sonatas are some of the most difficult works for organ and were composed as an organist's instruction manual for Bach's eldest son, Wilhelm Friedemann.

These trios demand that the organist play three equal and independent parts simultaneously with one part played in each hand and the third played by the feet. Tom says this is a true test of coordination and musical balance.
